Today Tuesday, date 29, month August, year 2023, at Depok, the undersigned below:

1. **Prof. Nina Nurmilla, Ph.D.** : Dean of Faculty of Education of **INDONESIAN INTERNATIONAL ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY (IIIU)**, located in Depok, West Jawa, Indonesia, hereafter refer to the **first party**
2. **Prof. Eka Srimulyani, MA., Ph.D** : Director of the Graduate School, act for and on behalf of the Graduate School of **UNIVERSITAS ISLAM NEGERI AR-RANIRY BANDA ACEH**, located in Darussalam, Banda Aceh 23111, hereafter refer to the second party.

The two parties agree on the following items:

- a. that the **FIRST PARTY** is the Faculty of Islamic Studies of the Indonesian International Islamic University (IIIU) which is responsible for organizing and implementing Education, Teaching and Research.

- b. that the **SECOND PARTY** is a Graduate School of Universitas Islam Negeri Ar-Raniry, in charge of coordinating and implementing the *Tridarma* of Higher Education in the field of education, research, and community service.

The Parties are desirous of entering into this MoU to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein:

CHAPTER 1

OBJECTIVES

Enhance cooperation in the domains of Education, Teaching, and Research by THE PARTIES. This partnership is part of the endeavor to accomplish the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which include Quality Education, Decent Employment and Economic Growth, and Partnerships for the Goals

CHAPTER 2

SCOPE


- a) **THE PARTIES** will collaborate in strengthening the competency of Human Resources through Masters/Masters Education (S2);
- b) **THE PARTIES** will collaborate in the areas of Education, Teaching, and Research;
- c) If necessary, the **SECOND PARTY** will support the **FIRST PARTY** in providing specialists, teaching staff/resources, and instructors in specific scientific subjects, based on the **FIRST PARTY**'s requirements; vice versa.;
- d) **THE PARTIES** will cooperate with respect to the usage of facilities, infrastructure, and other facilities necessary by the **SECOND PARTY** and the **FIRST PARTY**.;
- e) **THE PARTIES** may work together to organize seminars, conferences, workshops, symposia, and other scientific events;

CHAPTER 3

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATION OF THE FIRST PART

- 1) Rights of the **FIRST PARTY**
 - a. Acquire Human Resources in the **SECOND PARTY** in order to carry out joint activities in accordance with Chapter 2;
 - b. Along with the **SECOND PARTY**, ascertain the availability of a location for carrying out the activities described in Chapter 2; and
 - c. Together with the **SECOND PARTY**, conduct activities in accordance with Chapter 2.
- 2) Obligations of the **FIRST PARTY**

- b. Conduct activities in accordance with Article 2 with the **SECOND PARTY**.

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY

- 1) Rights of the **SECOND PARTY**
 - a. Acquire Human Resources in the **FIRST PARTY** in order to carry out joint activities in accordance with Chapter 2;
 - b. Along with the **FIRST PARTY**, ascertain the availability of a location for carrying out the activities described in Chapter 2; and
 - c. Together with the **FIRST PARTY**, conduct activities in accordance with Chapter
- 3) Obligations of the **SECOND PARTY**
 - a. Contribute to the activities mandated in Chapter 2 together with the **FIRST PARTY**, and
 - b. Conduct activities in accordance with Article 2 with the **FIRST PARTY**.

CHAPTER 4 TERMS OF COOPERATION

This partnership is applicable upon the execution of this Cooperation Agreement for up to three years.

CHAPTER 5 DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event of a disagreement, both sides will deliberate in order to seek a mutually beneficial resolution.


CHAPTER 6 MISCELLANEOUS
